<p>On 1 December [VALI/E/6] said that Soviet Consul Golub had told [VALI/R/1] that a western agent, who crossed the Finnish-Soviet border near Imatra on 18 May 1959 had been arrested and was being held by the Soviets. Golub did not reveal the name of the agent, but said that he had been trained in Austria. To the [redacted] knowledge, there have been no REDSOX missions run via Finland by KGB since 1953. Does Headquarters know of any REDSOX agents who disappeared in May?
