1. [SMABLE] would appreciate receiving any relevant information you may have on two Soviet Officials at present serving in Finland. They are:

- G. E. GOLUB - Soviet Consul
- N. MAKEEV - Correspondent for "Trud" *Trud - Finnish newspaper*

Both officials have been in social contact with members of the [SWADD] Legation in Helsinki. This contact instigated by GOLUB was allegedly to inquire about [SWADD] immigration procedure. MAKEEV acted as his interpreter throughout the meeting.

2. [SMABLE] has a trace in their files referring to G. E. GOLUB as Soviet Intelligence Officer acting as liaison man with the Finnish Security Police.

3. There seems furthermore to be a similarity here with the activities of Boris Lupovich TRETIAKOV (TRESTIAKOU) Head of the USSR Consular Section in Athens who has been conducting similar inquiries with the [SWADD] there.
