1. On the evening of 10 September [VACCINE/1] and his wife were at Franklin's home for dinner. It was supposed to be purely a social evening, and very little business was discussed. However, [VACCINE/1], who has been back from his five-week summer vacation for only one week, could not resist the urge to bring up the VAPID-Torreyean case. He said that he had read the interrogation report which had been prepared by one of his men and had subsequently talked to COUS on COUS's initiative. COUS had called him and invited him to lunch, and they had met last Thursday. From [VACCINE/1]'s account it appeared that COUS had described the incident at the airport quite factually, but [VACCINE/1] placed very little credence in the accuracy of the account. He said that in view of the fact that the six American athletes were left behind to admit visas, he could well understand that Torreyean had needled VAPID to the point of exaggeration. He does not believe that anything further will come of the case. Certainly the Ministry of Interior plans to forget about it unless a new protest comes from the Soviet Ambassador.

2. Presumably, COLES told VACCINE/1 that VIPID had behaved stupidly in the whole affair and has been recalled to the Soviet Union. (VACCINE/1 says he has already departed.) COLES also reported that VIPID is a married man. Apparently the Soviets, or at least COLES, do not believe VIPID's full story, according to VACCINE/1. The reason for this distrust is that when the sleeping incident occurred, VIPID had been speaking English to Turveyman. This report was evidently confirmed by the baggage master who witnessed the conflict. COLES thought it strange that VIPID, who speaks Finnish well, should not use that language in speaking to Turveyman, who also has a fair command of Finnish.
