1. Reference A does not give sufficient detail to make a very realistic appraisal at this time of the damage to our operations from the [redacted]

2. According to ANEYE-1, the head principal agent of our stay-behind nets in Cuba, AM [redacted] was kept fully informed of everything concerning operations and reporting. He also knew of the ANPARCH-1 agent net and how contact can be made with the agents. He was kept fully cognizant of all incoming and outgoing radio messages and reports.
