SUPDATA SOURCE LIENVOY TELCON BETWEEN VEGA AND PERSON WHO AGAIN IDENTIFIED SELF AS DR ALVAREZ. LIENVOY TRANSCRIBER AGAIN SAID IT VOICE OF GUTIERREZ. FOLLOWING VERBATIM TEXT LIENVOY TRANSCRIPTION WHICH STATION BELIEVES TO BE CODE: "GUTIERREZ AGRADECE A VEGA DE LA EMBAJADA CUBANA, EL ENVIO DE LAS OBRAS COMPLETAS, DE MARTI, ESTA MUY BONITA. VEGA DICE QUE NO TIENE POR QUE AGRADECER. EL DR ALVAREZ AGREGA QUE LA GENTE DE LA UNIVERSIDAD DE GUADALAJARA TAMBIEN QUIERE UNA CANTIDAD Y POR ESO LO MOLESTA. VEGA DE MOMENTO NO TIENE, PERO TRATARA DE QUEDAR BIEN".

1. ON 6 APRIL 1963 VICTOR MANUEL GUTIERREZ, PROMINENT GUATEMALAN COMMUNIST LEADER, WENT TO THE CUBAN EMBASSY TO MEET WITH MANUEL VEGA, CUBAN DIPLOMAT AND CHIEF OF THE CUBAN G-2 IN MEXICO. THE PURPOSE OF THE VISIT WAS TO THANK VEGA FOR A "PACKAGE" HE HAD SENT TO GUTIERREZ. (FIELD COMMENT: GUTIERREZ WAS ARRESTED AND JAILED IN GUATEMALA CITY IN FEBRUARY FOR "SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES." IT WAS ALSO REPORTED THAT A PERSON BELIEVED TO BE GUTIERREZ WAS IN CONTACT WITH THE CUBAN EMBASSY ON 29 MARCH 1963).
