Source, Operational Data, and Comments:

1. Source ^{or} [REDACTED] is of the opinion that WILSON is very probably an intelligence agent and that he is under direction of some service. There is no apparent reason for his great interest in the Yugoslav colony in Santiago, nor can [REDACTED] determine the source of WILSON's apparent large income. ₀₂
2. Despite the fact that much of what WILSON says is patently rubbish and although it was reported in TCS-1558 that he was believed to be mentally ill, [REDACTED] has been instructed to maintain contact with WILSON for the purpose of discovering what his objectives are and by whom he is directed. ₀₂
3. Any traces of WILSON at local quarters would be of assistance to this Station in pursuing this investigation.

1. Carlos John WILSON, an Englishman by birth but reported to be a Spanish citizen, was previously reported, among other activities, as posing as an ex-RAF pilot and veteran of World War II. His activities drew the attention of the British Embassy in Santiago and resulted in WILSON's being twice warned by the Chilean authorities to cease his masquerading or leave the country. According to source, WILSON has not taken the warnings very seriously, because he still openly talks of his exploits as an RAF pilot over Germany. [He also claims that, at the close of the war, he worked on a special mission for the British Government in Germany, Egypt and Turkey. He claimed in addition to have fought with the Spanish Republican forces against FRANCO. He states that he arrived in Santiago about five years ago.
2. WILSON is violently anti-U/S and constantly condemns Yankee imperialism, blaming the United States for the ills of the world as well as for his own personal set backs. WILSON states that England and France will eventually get together with Soviet Russia to form a pact aimed at the complete destruction of the United States. He claims to be an authority on the Balkans, and a great supporter of TITO whom he states is the only person capable of maintaining peace in that part of the world. TITO, WILSON states, will in time line up the entire Balkan area with England and France to assist Russia in crushing the United States.
3. WILSON evinces a great deal of interest in the Yugoslav Colony in Santiago and recently dropped in at the Club Ruso on a large celebration given by the Serbo Orthodox Society. He became quite drunk and so abusive of the U. S. that he was told to quiet down or leave. He confided to source on this occasion that he was in an intelligence service, implying that it was the British Intelligence. WILSON has an office on Calle Agustinas 1111, Office 418, telephone 83888, Casilla 863. On the door to this office appears the following: "CINCLA, Commercial Information". It is said that his office is usually full of Chileans, all of whom appear to be rabid Ibañistas and that the talk centers around the time when IBAÑEZ will take office and throw out the U. S. imperialists. WILSON's principal business consists in trading in copper, lead and sulfur, a business which he states is impeded by United States commercial espionage. According to WILSON, all requests for imports and exports in Chile clear through the Yankee Gestapo Headquarters on the sixth floor of the Carrera Hotel. However, WILSON now has a secret deal in Antofagasta wherein he plans to ship 15,000 tons of sulfur to Holland.

4. WILSON maintains close contacts with an individual identified as Heriberto Springwaller ~~EINICKE~~, also described as bitterly anti- U. S. EINICKE is alleged to have studied in the United States between 1922 and 1930. He later became a colonel in the ~~Chilean Army~~ and there ran afoul with the United States Embassy and was expelled from the country. It is reported that he spent a great deal of time in Bolivia and he is closely involved with WILSON in his so-called commercial deals.
5. WILSON is described as being very intelligent, astute and well informed on current events. He is extremely sociable, friendly, a very heavy drinker and a free spender. The physical description furnished by source is as follows:
