Juan VENTURA Valner - ~~Spanish~~ jeweler friend in Rome and Geneva. ~~(A-LASH-1)~~

Jose Luis LLONJO Y Benendez (lives in Paris - married to a cousin of the Comte de Paris) aka "El Flaco"

Jose Venegas Valdespino - possibly still back in Havana. A Vice-President of the International Union of Students (IUS) in Prague. Aka "El Chino" and "El Gene".

Luciano MELVES Mestre (in Madrid - LASH knows both Melves brothers well - other brother still in Cuba.) Trusts ~~...~~

Herman HERNANDEZ Lora - Spain

America Cisneros and her husband Mario Fissolo. Living Paris.

"Café Confites" - Luis Bruno GARCIA Cerdeira. Tries to find out LASH'S plans for French Intelligence, for which he works. Dangerous to LASH - but might try to trick a station by saying he's a friend - which he actually is.

Gustavo ARCO y Bergnes - Cuban Ambassador to Belgium. Currently still in Havana, but due back.

Luis CRESPO Castro - good friend to LASH-1. (Worked hard in Cuba to get ⁰² ~~UNIBNAFU/9~~ back in his job when he was first fired in Paris in early 64 or so. CRESPO travels constantly between Havana and Europe buying ships and materiel for ⁰² Castro. His use by LASH cannot be ruled out.)

⁰² ~~...~~ - knows LASH well - and for long. *06*

⁰² ~~...~~ - and his wife, ~~...~~ de ~~...~~ - normally Miami - travels Spain

⁰² ~~...~~ - was in Spain - going Paris. Better after nervous breakdown.

Felipe BLANCO Hernandez - CEB. Good friend to LASH for a long time. LASH believes him recruitable. He travels to Europe - so LASH could use him. Uses a second passport in name of Jacinto Cisneros.

Juanolo (Juan) RAY y Rivero - A-LASH-1. LASH in contact - and RAY travels to Europe from time to time.
