In a report dated 16 April 1964 it was stated that Violeta PEREZ Aceval, a Cuban wife of a Mexican businessman, Armia GONZALEZ Beytia, is a good friend of Mireya COUSO, the wife of Jose LAIN Martin Gonzalez, the Cuban Vice Consul in Merida, Mexico. Mireya told Violeta that she and LAIN were Socialists, not Communists. When Violeta remarked that this was the first step to Communism, Mireya replied that there is good money in it, but we are not Communists.

- S. A 10 May 1964 report stated that Jose LAIN Martin Gonzalez and his family arrived in Mexico City on 17 May 1964 and left for riabana on 15 May 1964. According to a source of this Agency who is a
