1. When shown the reference photograph, AMMUG/1 said it looked like Che GUEVARA. Other than this statement, AMMUG/1 could not identify the individual.
2. JMWAVE Station weapons specialist identified weapons in reference photograph as follows:
 - a. Weapon on the right is a U.S. caliber 30, M-1 or M-3 carbine. Identification is based on the stock, web type sling, and manner in which the sling is attached.
 - b. Weapon on the left, much less visible than the other weapon, appears to be a 1903 U.S. caliber 30 rifle. Identification is based on the stock and sling.
