The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

- 1. Source identified a photograph of Teudys THYTIE Matilla as being that of the person known to him as "Teobaldo" (true fall name nothknown the mount the same individual who was chief, also an instructor, of the Seccion Tecnica (Technical Training Section -ST) in the MI Department (Department of Technical Operational Support) in the Direction General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGI). His offices are located in Marianao.
- 2. Source described "Teobaldo" as being a Cuban citizen born about 1940. He is about five feet seven inches tall, weighs approximately 135 pounds, and has a slim build. He has a white complexion, light brown hair, a small, straight nose, a slim face, and is clean shaven. "Teobaldo" walks with a slight limp in his left leg and speaks with a nasal twang.1,2

Headquarters Comments

A former Cuban diplomat and Cuban Intelligence (CIS) staff officer who defected in 1963 reported that one Teovaldo TRUTIE (possibly identical with subject), born circa 1938, was a
