Pursuant to our discussion with you in New York on 18 January, we have talked with our colleagues about the possibility of arranging for qualified Cuban exiles Christian Democrats to teach in the project ~~CHIEF~~. They suggest that the best way to proceed would be for IDEN A or IDEN B to contact Jose Miro Cardona, head of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, in Miami and request him to recommend likely candidates. It was explained that:

- (1) Since the Cuban CO movement is a part of Cardona's Cuban Revolutionary Council, Cardona himself will have to approve the participation of Cuban Christian Democrats in the project ~~CHIEF~~.
- (2) Cardona, better than anyone else, can tell us who among Christian Democrats would be best for the job in terms of ability as a speaker and teacher and who at the same time would be spared (by Cardona) from the CRC for this purpose. Cardona's address is:

If you decide against contacting Cardona, we might be able to supply some names to add to those whom IDEN A or IDEN B doubtlessly already have access to independently.
