- 1. The VENUS, a 110-foot boat which is used as a mother ship by the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE, Cubana Revolutionary Junta), and two Boston Whalers, were in the American sector of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, on 20 July 1965. The government of Antonio Imbert Barrera had confiscated the weapons which were aboard, Including personal as well as boat-mounted weapons. Manuel Ray Rivero, leader of JURE, said that regardless of who won the struggle for power in the Dominican Republic, the weapons would be returned to JURE because JURE was on good terms with both sides of the conflict.
