

<p>Action: None. For Headquarters' information.</p> <p>Ref : HEMA-22257 dated 8 October 1963</p> <p>1. There follows the monthly operational report for Project LIENVOY activities during October 1963.</p> <p>2. <u>Target Lines - October 1963</u></p> <p>There was only one change in target lines during October. 20-68-69 was disconnected on 30 October to provide a free line for use against a LIENSOR target. The number and identity of this target will be provided when the new connection is made.</p> <p>3. <u>Processing of LIENVOY Information</u></p> <p>There was no change in the processing during this reporting period.</p> <p>4. <u>Exploitation of LIENVOY Information</u></p> <p>During this period LIENVOY provided operational data of interest in connection with the visit to Mexico of President Tito of Yugoslavia.</p> <p>MEKI-6453 reported a contact by an English-speaking man with the Soviet Embassy in Mexico City. This was forwarded to Headquarters for further dissemination.</p> <p>MEKI-6591 reported a long distance call from Herb PROVOSE from Las Vegas who claimed to be a student working with the Cuban Embassy in Mexico. Further dissemination was left to Headquarters.</p> <p>MEKI-6615 reported contact between New York Times writer, Herbert MATTHEWS and the Cuban Embassy in Mexico.
