1. The available evidence on given in reference cables, particularly in view of the conduct of JNA forces in Belgrade in its relations with officials, lends additional concern with the views expressed in reference cables. It would be of value if this station could be advised of any other official efforts of this kind that came to our attention. It might be that pertinent information would be presented by them.
2. There has come to our notice (through Dispatch 7474, dated October 21, 1952, reporting an attempt by Com. Djelic, First Secretary of the Yugoslav Legation in Belgrade, to secure information concerning American views on the AIA Com. of the Coordinating Communist Party. The tactics used remind us of Djelic; also, the subject of Djelic's interest ties the latter in with Djelic. Just in case you have not seen the dispatch we are enclosing a copy for you. (ie wonder whether the real intent of Djelic was not to feed the American source material back to us in Belgrade!) The expression "bear or with a club" might well be used in describing certain of our exchanges here in Belgrade!
