Douglas J. FREAPANE was introduced to Subject in February 1959 by AMOURETTE-9 in Havana to provide FREAPANE with first-hand information concerning the post-revolutionary high-level labor activities and to aid in the development of Project AMCALL.

Information given FREAPANE by Subject is ostensibly sent to JMCCLIPPER in PEPRIME via a courier system.
