

**SOURCE:**

A Cuban exile who was prominent in politics at the provincial level in Cuba, source is well known by the Cuban exiles and has reported objectively on their political maneuvers. Source occasionally receives information directly from Cuba. Source's reporting has lacked depth. This information was obtained from Nelson Rodriguez.

✓ On 8 December 1964 Nelson Rodriguez <sup>7070</sup> said that his brother, Reynol Rodriguez Gonzalez, <sup>Gonzalez</sup> had entered Cuba clandestinely in about October in order to arrange for the reception of Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo, <sup>2-201</sup> military leader of the Segundo Frente Nacional del Escambray (SFNE, Second National Front of the Escambray) and some of Gutierrez' men. Reynol made this trip with a group of friends and entered Cuba via the Finca La Guasima, part of which borders on the Bay of Cardenas, Matanzas Province. Reynol has made several trips there, not only to exfiltrate personnel but to infiltrate them as well. Nelson and his brothers were born on the Finca Guasima and have many contacts in the neighboring areas.

✓ 2. Noel <sup>70291</sup> Galas, <sup>LT</sup> former lieutenant in the Rebel Army, has left for Cuba; he is a member of Gutierrez' group. <sup>SFNE</sup>

3. Nelson, who arrived in Miami by boat in about August 1964, said that he might leave for Cuba soon to try to exfiltrate his mother and brothers. However, he will probably also take some men in with him who are collaborating with members of the Cuban Rebel Army in a plot to assassinate Fidel Castro Ruz.

1. Field Comment: According to [redacted] dated 8 October 1964, Reinol Rodriguez Gonzalez had been missing from the Miami area since about 21 September. It was rumored that he and two other persons had joined Gutierrez at his camp.
2. Source Comment: Nelson Rodriguez, who is 18 years old, is the nephew of Roger Rodriguez Sosa, husband of Lucia Echeverria Bianchi, the sister of the student martyr, Jose Antonio Echeverria.
3. Field Comment: According to [redacted], dated 20 May 1964, Salas was one of three members of Gutierrez' group who were believed to have left Miami by 17 May 1964.
