

**G I B S O N** Richard Thomas, US-citizen, DPOB 15 May 1931 Los Angeles, journalist & translator, US-pp. B-131934, issued Washington 26 Jan 1961; married to Jay Marjorie née KATE, DPOB 12 July 1925 London, British subject, British pp. C 156546, also a journalist; 2 children; domiciled in Lausanne, 17 embailliers du marché. Arrived in Lausanne from Algiers in late April 1963.

**A N D E R S S O N** Fredy Gilbert Kils, DPOB 14 Febr 1933 Lausanne, Swedish citizen, editor-publisher (Editions "La Cité"; editor-secretary of "Société co-opérative CLARTÉ EDITIONS") with offices at 10-11 Métropole, LAUSANNE.

ANDERSSON has been known for the last 10 years to have numerous contacts in international leftist circles of all shades -including FLN-Algerians, Congolese, Angolans, other African politicians, Spanish emigres, French "réfractaires anti-colonialistes", etc.. - Despite all these contacts he cannot definitely be labelled as a communist.

[redacted] cross contacts with CHICOM-Embassy in Switzerland, particularly with Cultural Attaché JAC Hein, 1914. In April 1963 [redacted] that ANDERSSON published a luxury-edition of a brochure entitled "LES MACHINES ET REVISIIONISME MODERNE" on Chicom orders -which raised a lot of unfavorable reactions in PIA-circles! 3000 Copies are said to have been shipped to China. When Vicepresident LO Chuan, 1912, of the Committee for Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries, stayed in Switzerland in April 1963, he reportedly met ANDERSSON and placed more orders for publishing by ANDERSSON of Chinese communist brochures supporting the Chicom line in the present Sino-Soviet ideological controversy. He is the distributor for Switzerland of the monthly review "REVOLUTION AFRICAINE" which is published in Paris.

GIBSON and his wife are employed by ANDERSSON, i.e. the Paris publishing firm, and they are responsible for translation, proof-reading, etc. of the English-language edition "AFRICAN REVOLUTION" which is printed in Lausanne.
