1. REF CABLES PROBABLY REFER TO SAME EXPEDITION.

2. LOCAL LHERGO NOTIFIED STATION 24 OCTOBER THAT LHPURE CONSUL MERIDA MEXICO REPORTED REF GROUP 19 OCT ALLEGEDLY LEFT FROM PROGRESO MEXICO FOR GUATEMALA (NOT CUBA AS SURMISED REF G) YACHT "EL AMIGO." TWO UNIDENTIFIED MEXICANS FORCED GO ALONG. MEXICANS CHECKING TO DETERMINE IF THEY OWNERS OF BOAT.

3. SEVERAL MEXICO NEWSPAPERS CARRIED STORY 24 OCT RE PRESENCE REF GROUP IN MERIDA. YACHT "EL AMIGO" HAD BASIC RANGE 969 MILES BUT SPARE FUEL IN DRUM OBSERVED ON DECK. MEXICANS ESTIMATE BOAT WILL HAVE TO REFUEL NEAR BELIZE BRITISH HONDURAS.

4. LOCAL LHERGO FURNISHED FOLL INFO RE PERSONS INVOLVED SUSPECTED YACHT HIJACKING.

A. FRANK ANGELO VIGORINI TOLD LHERGO SOURCE THAT HE AND GROUP PLANNED GO GUATEMALA TO CLEAN OUT ANTI-GUATEMALAN GUERRILLAS AND SET UP BASE OF OPERATIONS FOR OPS AGAINST CUBA. FOR THIS WOULD BE PAID 1000 DOLLARS PER MONTH AND 10,000 DOLLARS ON COMPLETION OF MISSIONS. HE CLAIMED TWO OF MEN WHO ARE

B. ALSO IN ABOVE GROUP ^{AKA:} MAX GORMAN WHO IDENTIFIED BY
 LNERGO AS MAXIMILIANO GONZALEZ. GORMAN WITH ALLEGED WIFE SHERYL
 CROSSED INTO MEXICO AT MATAMOROS 22 AUGUST IN BLUE 1968 CANARO
 WITH FLORIDA PLATES 32-3487. CAR PAPERS SHOWED DONALD CLAUS
 OWNER. LNERGO IDENTIFIED CLAUS AS FORMER MARINE WITH MARINE
 CORP TATTOO ON ARM. THEY POSSIBLY ACCOMPANIED BY RAYMOND AND
 LYNN ^{AKA:} DANNISTER WHO WERE LISTED MATAMOROS BORDER RECORDS AS
 CROSSING 22 AUGUST AS PASSENGERS IN 1968 CANARO. THEIR NAMES
 LISTED CONSECUTIVELY AFTER GORMANS AND CLAUS.

C. FINGINI SAID GROUP WOULD SELL THE CANARO IN MEXICO
 TO RAISE MONEY FOR HIS OPERATIONS. SINCE NO WOMEN OBSERVED ON
 YACHT LNERGO BELIEVES SHERYL ^{AKA:} IDENTIFIED AS WIFE OF MICHAEL ^{AKA:}
 SCHLEGELER (MIAMI BOAT OWNER) AND OTHER UNIDENTIFIED WOMEN PROBABLY
