1. Mr. Frank Waterman, representative of the US State Dept. in Miami, advised this office that Subject arrived in the US on 31 Mar 61 as an exile and that he might have information of interest to this office.

2. On 4 Apr 61, Luis J.C. Rodriguez interviewed Subject in Waterman's office. An examination of Subject's passport disclosed that he was born on 23 Jan 1933 in Havana, Cuba.

3. Subject stated that he is a member of a clandestine organization named Unidos Revolucionarios (UR), which is composed of 16 underground groups. The Coordinator for military operations of UR was Major Humberto SOSI Marin, who was arrested recently. Among the leaders of UR are Rogelio QUEJALIZ better known by his name de guerra of "Francisco"; and Rafael DIAZ aka "Ralph". All these individuals were arrested recently and UR is completely disorganized as a result.

4. Subject also stated that his mission with UR was to serve as courier between the organization and the [redacted] of the Cabana fortress. The liaison between the [redacted] and Subject was [redacted] who is the sexton at the [redacted] in the suburb of Miramar, near Havana.

5. Subject also made a trip to Sancti Spiritus in the Province of Las Villas bringing a radio transmitter for the anti-Castro guerrillas operating in the Encumbey. Through the above mentioned [redacted], Subject obtained some information furnished by prisoners held in the Cabana fortress which is being forwarded to report [redacted].

6. Subject intends to remain in the US indefinitely and has been instructed to contact a Cuban national named "Eusebio", who resides at 1320 N.W. 22nd St., Miami. Eusebio is the UR representative in Miami.

7. No further contacts with Subject are anticipated.
