Former members of the United Free Socialist Army go to help ANGEL-1 because of  
State Department request*

ACTION REQUESTED: None, NYI

1. An MFO subscriber [redacted] reported on 12 December 1961 that he had that day, by chance, met General R. GUEVARA, a former colleague of Dr. Arnulfo RODRIGUEZ in Guatemala, at the New Orleans Airport. *2d-12-84-303*

2. [redacted] stated that GUEVARA told him that he was returning that day from a trip to Mexico and Guatemala. In Mexico he had talked to Presidente GIFFARD and had found him to be indecisive, but, to the contrary, when he had talked to Presidente YDROGOAS in Guatemala he had found him extremely anxious to have CASTRO eliminated. YDROGOAS had asked GUEVARA about his visit to CHAVEZ, and when GUEVARA expressed his opinion, YDROGOAS said it was logical because CHAVEZ was extremely cowardly.

3. According to [redacted] GUEVARA further said that a short time ago he had been called by Mr. Bob Burwitz, chief of the Cuban Desk in the State Department, and that Burwitz had told him not to fool around with SANCHEZ or Julio CARRASCO because the man who had the support of the U.S. was ANGEL-1, and that as he, Burwitz, had knowledge of the great work done by GUEVARA, he did not want him to continue losing more time.

4. [redacted] added that GUEVARA told that a few days later he received a phone call from ANGEL-1. GUEVARA told SANCHEZ that he will help ANGEL-1, because it was requested, but he would never have done so by his own wish.

5. [redacted] said that GUEVARA continued his travel on to Washington, where he resided at 1119 - 27th Street, N.W., Washington 7.
