SUBJECT: Operational/SECURITY
Former proposal of Dr. Aureliano SANCHEZ Arango to help AMIB-1 members of State Department request

ACTION REQUIRED: None, FYI

1. An AMOT subsource [redacted] reported on 12 December 1961 that he had that day, by chance, met RAFAEL S. GIBRGA, a former delegate of Dr. Aureliano SANCHEZ Arango, at the New Orleans Airport. *201-284303*
2. [redacted] stated that GIBRGA said that he was returning that day from a trip to Panama and Guatemala. In Panama he had talked to President CHIARI and had found him to be intimidated, but, to the contrary, when he had talked to President YDIGORAS in Guatemala he had found him extremely anxious to have CASTRO liquidated. YDIGORAS had asked GIBRGA about his visit to CHIARI, and when GIBRGA expressed his opinion, YDIGORAS said it was logical because CHIARI was extremely cowardly.
3. According to [redacted] GIBRGA further said that a short time ago he had been called by Mr. Bob Hurwitch, Chief of the Cuban Desk in the State Department, and that Hurwitch had told him not to fool around with SANCHEZ or Julio GARCERAN because the man who had the support of the U.S. was AMIB-1, and that as he, Hurwitch, had knowledge of the great work done by GIBRGA, he did not want him to continue losing more time.
4. [redacted] added that GIBRGA said that a few days later he received a phone call from AMIB-1. GIBRGA told AMIB-1 that he will help AMIB-1, because it was requested, but he would never have done so by his own wish.
5. [redacted] said that GIBRGA continued his travel on to Washington, where he resides at 1419 - 27th Street, N.W., Washington 7.
