1. Headquarters appreciates the very complete and detailed reports received from PASSAVOY concerning his meetings with AMBUD-1 and leaders of member organizations. PASSAVOY is to be commended for his handling of AMBUD-1, his quick grasp of the importance of security, and his excellent reporting.

2. Headquarters is aware of the Station's shortage of personnel, particularly in the stenographic staff, but suggests that, insofar as possible, PASSAVOY's reports be separated by subject. If notes dealing with propaganda, for example, could be submitted separately from those dealing with paramilitary matters, it would expedite and simplify distribution at Headquarters to appropriate action elements. When feasible, separate dispatches for memoranda dealing with each subject would be appreciated. It is requested also that an original and two copies of each memoranda be forwarded.

3. It is noted that several of PASSAVOY's reports contain recommendations or requests for information on which to base a reply to AMBUD-1. In some instances it is not clear whether the station has taken action, or whether it is expected from Headquarters. It is requested that the Station's covering dispatch state clearly when action by Headquarters is desired.
