SUBJECT

: U. 5. Arny Enlistment Program for Cebans

- 1. You will recall that on 7 June 1964 your office gave us the names of eight Cuben-torn U. S. Army privates who were creating difficulties at Ft. Jackson, claiming that commitments concerning their enlistments were not being howored. A letter was sent to each of these men at our request by manuel Antonio de VARUNA y Larodo, head of the Movimieste de Rescate Constitucional Democratico, urging them not to jeopardise, by their indiscreet actions, a program believed to be in the best interests of the Cuban Revolutionary Council. These were individually written letters and were mailed as 14 and 15 Jane.
- In this connection, there is attached to all UPI selease from Pt. Jackson which was published in the Athanton Post on 17 June 1964. Car office in his and has add that the same story also appeared to the Miami hierald on the same date.
- I. Although we assume that the eight men referred to in the UFI release are identical with the individuals to whom letters were sent by VARONA and that the immediate problem called to our attention on 7 June has been resolved, our representatives in Mami believe that this incident is indicative of problems that will probably arise under the new U.S. Army program as they now understand it.
