1. REQUEST [] PASS TO USIA FOLLOWING INFO RE REF:

AMLASH-1 WAS IN MONT 3 TO 7 JUNE 1960 AS GUEST OF FEDERATION OF URUGUAYAN UNIVERSITY STUDENTS. HE HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE AT FEUU HEADQUARTERS; SPOKE AT THE UNIVERSITY AND MET PRIVATELY WITH FEUU LEADERS. HE FOLLOWED THE CASTRO PROP LINE USING SUCH SLOGANS AS: FATHERLAND OR DEATH; DEATH TO TRAITORS; AND ^{ANTI-}CASTRO STUDENTS SERVE BASTARD INTERESTS. HE APPARENTLY DISCUSSED WITH STUDENT LEADERS THE FORTHCOMING L.A. YOUTH CONFERENCE TO BE HELD IN HAVA IN JULY 1960.

2. KUBARK PROP HAS CONCENTRATED ON GROWING UNEAS, AGITATION (NOT RIOT) AMONG UNIVERSITY STUDENTS AND THEIR DISCREET BUT OPEN DEFIANCE OF G.O.C. CASTRO OBLIGED INSTITUTE PREVENTIVE AND PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES, SENDING STUDENTS TO CANE FIELDS AND PLACING UNIVERSITY UNDER TIGHTER CONTROL. KUBARK REFRAINING FROM MENTION AMLASH-1 ALLEGED CONNECTION KUBARK.
