Miguel Angel ^{Escobar} CORO Corao, a Cuban refugee who arrived in Madrid on 21 February 1965, reported during an interview at QU/EB that (Identity A), a Cuban Rebel Army officer, is engaged in counterrevolutionary activities against the Castro regime. Identity A, who is probably identical with the Subject of 201-142291, has been helping infiltration teams on arrival in Cuba. Source obtained the above information from Identity A's uncle, not further identified.</p> <p>2. Identity A is employed by Identity B and travels frequently within Cuba. He has apparently come under suspicion by the DSE, since he is reportedly kept under strict surveillance.</p>
