4. L-9 reported as follows:

J. Letter to MIRABAL.

MIRABAL seemed to feel he had a hot potato on his hands, was very uncomfortable and even a bit scared and said, "I'll have to discuss this with the Ambassador." (Let notes that MIRABAL is cowardly, timorous, not at all like his predecessor AZCUS who was the epitome of self confidence and control. Let finds this interesting since AZCUE was not a Communist and MIRABAL is — the Communist is really the weakling in spite of all the strength that supposedly comes from knowing that Marxism-Leninism is right.)

1. A meeting with 1-9 took place from 2010 until 2145 hours 30 Jan 1980 at the safe spartment, (1-9) was in summissingly good spirite, showed none of his usual depression.

2. (L-9) reported on the following:

a. On Saturday 18 Jan at the usual Embassy staff meeting, several saw "naig atmos conrid" A . tuc beerg erow eterngiesa wen announced and during this period staff members, in addition to their usual duties, will prepare special reports on several e topics. Raul APARICI? will do a report on the National University physical plant, student body, activities, ways in which the Cubam government can exert influence, etc. L-9 will

MACHADO will do a report on countries which have diplomatic relations with Cuba -- emphasizing how contact with representatives here in Mexico of such countries may be parlayed into something more worthwhile for the Castro government. Rogelio PDDRIGUEZ was given an assignment as Political Reporting Officer.

At this meeting Guillerno RUIZ of the Commercial Office -- who has . recently been energing as a fanatical Fidelista -- spoke out about the recent accord between the USSR and Cuba, saying that 15 was convenient for the USSR to keep on the good side of Cuba and thus keep a darger in the back of the imperialists. Ambassador HERNANDEZ Armas, somewhat taken aback by RUIZ' language, pointed out that the relationship between the USR and Cubs is based, above all, on the highest principles of international friendship.

b. Last Wednesday (29 Jan) a Soviet official, Boris T. RUDENKO, wisited the Cultural Department and spoke with APARICIO and L-9. 1-9 took pains to "be a good Communist" during this encounter. (This comversation was picked up by (METRAP) RUDENKO was also at the home of Horacio FLORES Sanchez on the 28th after the Marti bawage session at the Cuban Cultural Institute.

A Bolivian woman - name possibly VILLILBA - was recently at the Hotel Oxford with 7 children, waiting to go to Cuba to join her husband who works there (1-2) believes she has gone on to Cuba.

On 17 January Cuban delegates to the CEPAL Conference visited the Embassy and spoke with Embassy employees. One of these delegates, referring to the Nicaro plant in Cuon, said that only 12 engineers of the original 37 remained. Of case, a man named (fau) PRESILIA was still doing an excellent job although he is physically in poor condition.
