1. IRAQ: //SHARP COMPETITION FOR POWER IS RAMPERING THE NEW IRAQI REGIME'S ATTEMPTS TO ESTABLISH ITSELF FIRMLY.//

//ANTI-BAATHIST ARMY OFFICERS ARE STILL UNHAPPY OVER THE ROLE THAT BAATHISTS PLAY IN THE REGIME. A NON-BAATHIST FACTION IN THE GOVERNMENT IS PRESSING FOR REDUCTION OF BAATHIST INFLUENCE AND FOR THE ARREST AND TRIAL OF LEADERS OF THE EXTREMIST BAATH FACTION.//

//PROBABLY AS A RESULT OF THIS PRESSURE, BAATHISTS ARE BEING ELIMINATED FROM KEY POSITIONS IN THE INTELLIGENCE AND SECURITY SERVICES, A NEW ARMY DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF HAS BEEN APPOINTED, AND A NUMBER OF ARMY OFFICERS RETIRED.//

//AN ARMY BRIGADE CONSIDERED LOYAL TO PRES ARIF HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO BAGDAD TO COUNTER THE INFLUENCE OF THE BAATHIST-LED GUN DIVISION.

WHICH HAD A MAJOR PART IN THE 18 NOV COUP. THERE HAS BEEN NO WHOLESALE PURGE OF BAAATHISTS IN THE ARMY, AND GOVERNMENT SPOKESMEN REITERATE THE LINE THAT THE COUP WAS NOT DIRECTED AGAINST ANY PARTY.//

//BAAATHISTS IN THE GOVERNMENT, HEADED BY DEFENSE MINISTER HARDAN THIRITI AND VICE PRESIDENT BAKR, REPORTEDLY ARE DESIRING FOR GRADUAL RESURPTION OF BAAATHIST CONTROL AND FOR CONTINUATION OF BAAATH POLICIES. ~~RECENTLY~~ THIRITI IS ALSO REPORTED TO BE PROTECTING BAAATHISTS ~~RECENTLY~~ ARRESTED BY SECURITY OFFICIALS.//

//PRESIDENT AVIF AND PREMIER TAJIB YANHA ARE TRYING TO MAINTAIN A NEUTRAL POSITION. YANHA BELIEVES THAT THE PRESENT SITUATION MAY EVENTUALLY LEAD TO ANOTHER COUP.//

2. SYRIA: //POLITICAL TENSION IN SYRIA HAS INCREASED CONSIDERABLY DURING THE PAST THREE DAYS AND A COUP MAY BE DEVELOPPING. BAAATHIST PARTY FOUNDERS AFLAQ AND BITAR HAVE ASKED FOR VISAS TO GO ABROAD, WHILE SEVERAL CONSERVATIVE LEADERS HAVE BEEN RELEASED FROM CUSTODY. THERE ARE ALSO INDICATIONS THAT ATTEMPTS ARE BEING MADE TO OUST BAAATHIST VICE PREMIER GENERAL UBRAN.// (COBT)

KHUZESTAN ARABS IN SOUTHEASTERN IRAN. TEHRAN FEARS THAT ARAB  
 NATIONALIST ACTIVITIES THERE ARE RECEIVING OUTSIDE SUPPORT.//

//SAVAK, THE IRANIAN SECURITY AND INTELLIGENCE ORGANIZATION,  
 REPORTEDLY ARRESTED ABOUT 100 ARABS IN KHUZESTAN PROVINCE ON 26 NOV,  
 AND THE ROUNDUP IS CONTINUING. LOCAL ARAB DISSIDENT ACTIVITY HAS  
 APPARENTLY BEEN UNDER CLOSE WATCH FOR SOME TIME, BUT THE LARGE  
 NUMBER OF ARRESTS APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN ORDERED FROM TEHRAN, WHERE  
 THERE IS AN EXAGGERATED APPREHENSION OVER ARAB "UNITY" MOVEMENTS.//

4. TURKEY: PRIME MINISTER INONU'S COALITION GOVERNMENT RE-  
 SIGNED 2 DEC AFTER 17 MONTHS OF UNREST AND INSTABILITY.

INONU'S RESIGNATION WAS PRECIPITATED BY THE DEFEAT OF THE TWO  
 MINOR PARTIES IN HIS COALITION BY THE OPPOSITION JUSTICE PARTY (JP)  
 IN THE RECENT LOCAL ELECTIONS. PRESIDENT GURSEL HAS ASKED INONU'S  
 CABINET TO STAY ON UNTIL ANOTHER CAN BE FORMED. AFTER INONU'S  
 FIRST COALITION COLLAPSE IN JUNE 1962, NEARLY A MONTH PASSED BEFORE  
 HE WAS ABLE TO PULL TOGETHER A NEW GOVERNMENT.

SOME LESS CONTROVERSIAL FIGURE MAY BE CHOSEN TO TAKE THE LEAD  
 THIS TIME. DISCUSSION OF A NEW COALITION HAS CENTERED ON TWO

5. CYPRUS: //GREEK AND TURKISH CYPRIOT LEADERS EVIDENTLY ARE NEAR A BREAKDOWN OVER THE QUESTION OF REVILING CYPRUS' CONSTITUTION.//

CYPRUS GOVERNMENT MAKARIOS HAS FORMALLY GIVEN VICE PRESIDENT EUCHE, THE LEADER OF THE TURKISH COMMUNITY, A MEMORANDUM PROPOSING EXTENSIVE MODIFICATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS WHICH THE TURKS REGARD AS GUARANTEING THEIR MINORITY RIGHTS. TURKISH CYPRIOT LEADERS, SUPPORTED BY THE TURKISH GOVERNMENT, HAVE CONSISTENTLY REJECTED ANY SUCH MODIFICATIONS.//

//MAKARIOS PREVIOUSLY INDICATED THAT HE ULTIMATELY MIGHT ACT UNILATERALLY TO CONVOKE A CONSTITUTIONAL ASSEMBLY IF THE TURKISH COMMUNITY REFUSES TO AGREE TO HIS BASIC DEMANDS. HE INSISTS THESE ARE ESSENTIAL IF CYPRUS IS TO HAVE A WORKABLE GOVERNMENT.//

//THE ALREADY STRAINED RELATIONS BETWEEN GREEK AND TURKISH CYPRIOTS WILL DEGRADATE RAPIDLY IF MAKARIOS ACTUALLY MOVES TO OVERRIDE THE TURKS' OPPOSITION. BOTH GREEK AND TURKISH COMMUNITIES HAVE PARAMILITARY ORGANIZATIONS WHICH ARE REPORTED READY TO ACT
