

1. ~~SECRET~~ KELPTON RECEIVED COPY OF LETTER FROM MURKIN TO COYED COVERING HIS JOB AS ORGANIZER IN 1964 AND ACCORDINGLY KEEPS COPY FOR ORGANIZERS CONFERENCE. KELPTON NOTED OUT COYED'S UNKNOWN REPUTATION AND SUGGESTED CHECK WITH STURGES.
2. ~~SECRET~~ COYED SAYS HE WOULD NOT HIRE COYED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. HE CONSIDERS COYED A CHOKER, ONLY INTERESTED IN MONEY AND UNDESTITUTEDLY WOULD BETRAY HIS POLITICAL VIEWS ON THE CAP PAYROLL. COYED SAYS COYED WAS CLASSED INITIALLY OF INTELLIGENCE OF FIVE, BUT IF COYED MAINTAINS THIS CLASSIFICATION A TECHNICALITY AND HE GETS \$125,000. KELPTON SAYS HE WILL BE ANOTHER INTERVIEW. THIS OFFER IS NOT COYED'S PREFERENCE.
3. ~~SECRET~~ COYED REPORTEDLY HAS BEEN TOLD BY CIA AND PARAPOLITICALLY BY STURGES. HIS BELIEF IS THAT AND NEED COMMUNAL CUBAN GROUPS ACTIVITIES ARE SERIOUSLY DISRUPTED DURING VENEZUELAN CIVIL. PLAINFIELD BELIEVES COYED IS APPROXIMATELY SIX MONTHS AWAY. COYED INDICATED PLAINFIELD WORKING DAY BEFORE COYED COULD BELIEVE HE COULD GIVE COYED CONSIDERATION TO OFFERS OF U.S. AUTHORITIES. COYED ADVISED COYED NO SPECIAL FUNDS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ANY PROGRAM PREPARED BY COYED.
