1. CUBA: PHOTOGRAPHY OF 17 DEC SHOWS A NEW SAM SITE UNDER CONSTRUCTION NEAR PERSTON, A FEW MILES WEST OF THE NICARO SAM SITE. NO SAM EQUIPMENT IN PLACE AT THE NEW SITE, BUT LAUNCH AND GUIDANCE POSITIONS ARE BEING PREPARED AND SEVERAL BUILDINGS AND CUBAN TENTS HAVE BEEN ERECTED. EQUIPMENT FROM THE NICARO SITE WILL PROBABLY BE MOVED TO THE NEW LOCATION, WHICH WILL AFFORD BETTER PROTECTION FOR PORT AND REEL NAVAL FACILITIES IN BAHIA DE NIQUE AND BAHIA

2. LATIN AMERICA: A MEETING OF REPRESENTATIVES OF LATIN AMERICAN COMMUNIST PARTIES MAY BE HELD IN RIO DE JANEIRO ON OR ABOUT 27 DEC. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WOULD BE TO MAKE PLANS FOR COUNTERING THE EXPECTED OAS REPORT ON CUBAN ARMS SHIPMENTS TO VENEZUELA

3. ECUADOR - FORMER PRESIDENT ^EARGENTIÑA, ALTHOUGH NOT CONSIDERED A THREAT TO THE MILITARY JUNTA WHICH DEPOSED HIM ON 11 JULY, IS CONTINUING TO PLOT A COUNTERCoup. ~~ARGENTIÑA~~, HE HAS OBTAINED SUPPORT OF A NUMBER OF JUNIOR OFFICERS AND SUBSISTED IN THE COASTAL PROVINCES. ARGENTIÑA'S TIMETABLE CALLS FOR MOVING ON 18 DEC, TROOP DISTURBANCES ON 24 DEC, AND "DECISIVE ACTION" AT THE YEAR'S END.

4. VENEZUELA; THE COMMUNIST-SELECTED ARMED FORCES OF NATIONAL LIBERATION (FALN) REPORTEDLY PLANNED TO KIDNAP ANOTHER HIGH-RANKING GOV OFFICIAL BEFORE 24 DEC "TO MAINTAIN THE GOVERNMENT AND THE PUBLIC IN A STATE OF TENSION." FALN TERRORISTS HAVE RESUMED THEIR CAMPAIGN AGAINST US-OWNED PROPERTY IN CARACAS. AN ATTACK ON THE OFFICE OF THE READERS DIGEST ON 13 DEC WAS THE FIRST SUCH INCIDENT SINCE THE 1 DEC ELECTIONS. CENTRAL AMERICA - GUATEMALA: MINISTERS OF DEFENSE OF PANAMA AND ALL OF THE CENTRAL AMERICAN COUNTRIES EXCEPT COSTA RICA--WHICH TRADITIONALLY HAS BEEN SKEPTICAL OF FORMAL MILITARY ORGANIZATIONS AND AGREEMENTS--WERE SCHEDULED TO MEET IN GUATEMALA CITY ON 13 DEC TO CONSIDER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COUNCIL OF CENTRAL AMERICAN DE-

THE CHIEF PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED ORGANIZATION WOULD BE TO ADOPT JOINT MEASURES TO COMBAT COMMUNISM WITHIN THE AREA OF THE GUATEMALA REGIME OF GUATEMALA. THE PRINCIPAL BACKER OF THE MEETING HAS FOR A LONG TIME PROMOTED THE FORMAL ESTABLISHMENT OF A DEFENSE COUNCIL (CONF)

6. BOLIVIA: ^{REFER} DISCUSSIONS STEMMING FROM THE EVENTS SURROUNDING THE CAPTURE AND RELEASE OF HOSTAGES BY DISSIDENT TIN MINERS WILL BE FELT FOR A LONG TIME. THE SPLIT BETWEEN PRESIDENT PAZ AND VICE PRESIDENT LECHIN SEEMS UNBRIDGEABLE AND AN EARLY SHOWDOWN BETWEEN THEM IS ~~LIKELY TO OCCUR~~ LIKELY TO OCCUR NEXT MONTH WHEN THEIR PARTY CONVENES TO SELECT CANDIDATES FOR NEXT YEAR'S PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION. ALTHOUGH LECHIN BOWED TO GOVERNMENT PRESSURE IN ORDERING THE HOSTAGES RELEASED, ^{HE} IS STILL STANDING ON A MILITANT PLATFORM ^{AND} ~~HE~~ MAY ALSO HAVE THOUGHTS OF PROMOTING ARMED INSURRECTION; HE IS KNOWN TO HAVE TOYED WITH THE IDEA IN THE PAST.

7. MEXICO // MEXICO WILL OPPOSE CENSURE OF CUBA BY ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES (OAS) FOR INTERVENTION IN VENEZUELAN AFFAIRS.

FOREIGN MINISTER TELLO STATED THAT THE MEXICAN POSITION IS "STAY." TELLO BELIEVES THAT THE VEREUBLAN CHANGE OF CASTRO AIMS SUICIDE IS MERELY A "PLANT," AND THAT THERE IS NO EVIDENCE OF FOREIGN INTERVENTION IN VEREUBLAN AFFAIRS. //

TELLO'S POSITION, GENERALLY SHARED BY BRAZIL, WILL PROBABLY ENCOURAGE SOME LESSER OAS MEMBERS TO EQUIVOCATE ON THE CUBANS. //

IN 11 DEC PRESS INTERVIEW, TELLO ASSERTED THAT THE OAS ITSELF IS IN A CRISIS, PARTIALLY AS THE RESULT OF CUBA'S EXCLUSION FROM THE ORGANIZATION.

8. BRAZIL: THERE IS GROWING POSSIBILITY THE CABINET WILL BE RESHUFFLED BEFORE LONG. PRESIDENT GOULART KEEPING HIS OWN COUNCIL ON CHANGES HE MAY BE CONTEMPLATING. POSITION OF FINANCE MINISTER CARVALHO PINTO IS PERHAPS SHAKIEST BECAUSE OF THE WIDESPREAD DISSATISFACTION WITH RAMPAANT INFLATION AND GROWING UNEMPLOYMENT. TWO OTHER CABINET JOBS ARE PRESENTLY VACANT, BUT THERE ARE NO FIRM INDICATIONS WHO WILL BE APPOINTED TO THEM. GOULART IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE HIS PRACTICE OF ATTEMPTING TO BALANCE OFF THE RIGHT AND LEFT, BUT WITH A LEFTIST BIAS. (SECRET)

PRESIDENT GOULART ISSUED A DECREE ON 10 DEC THAT MAY PRESAGE THE CANCELLATION OF US AND ~~SEE~~ OTHER FOREIGN-OWNED MINING CONCESSION IN BRAZIL. THE DECREE DIRECTS THE MINISTER OF MINES TO REVIEW ALL MINING OPERATIONS WITHIN 90 DAYS AND TO HALT WITHIN 30 DAYS ANY OPERATIONS WHICH FAIL TO MEET CERTAIN CONDITIONS. THE MINISTER IS GIVEN SUCH BROAD DISCRETION THAT HE MAY, FOR EXAMPLE, CLOSE DOWN MINING ACTIVITIES "CONSIDERED PREJUDICIAL TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST." FOREIGN MINING COMPANIES HAVE BEEN UNDER INTEREST ATTACK BY THE EXTREME LEFT DURING RECENT MONTHS, PARTICULARLY IN THE STATE OF MINAS GERAIS WHERE A GOVERNOR HAS TAKEN STEPS TO CANCEL CONCESSIONS OF THOUS-OWNED HANNA MINING COMPANY. 6. CHILE: THE SLIM HOPES OF COMMUNIST-BACKED PRESIDENTIAL ASPIRANT SALVADOR ALLENDE MAY BE IMPROVED BY THE FAILURE OF JULIO DURAN--THE NOMINEE OF THE RADICAL, LIBERAL, AND CONSERVATIVE PARTIES-- TO CAPTURE THE PUBLIC'S IMAGINATION.

IF THE DURAN CANDIDACY SHOULD COLLAPSE, THE CONTEST WOULD BE BETWEEN ALLENDE AND CHRISTIAN DEMOCRAT ~~NEEDS~~ EDUARDO FREI, WITH INDEPENDENT RIGHTIST JORGE PRAT PRESENTLY PROVIDING AN ELEMENT OF

19 PERU: THE GOVERNMENT COALITION HEADED BY PRESIDENT FERNANDO
 BELAUNDE TERRY APPEARS TO HAVE SCORED A MAJOR VICTORY IN THE COUNTRY'S
 15 DEC MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS. THE FIRST OF THEIR KIND HELD IN PERU IN
 10 YEARS.

EX-MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND GOVERNMENT CANDIDATE LUIS BEDOYA
 WAS AN UPSET VICTOR IN THE IMPORTANT RACE FOR MAYOR OF LIMA. BEDOYA'S
 DEFEAT OF THE WIFE OF EX-PRESIDENT MANUEL ODRIA SURPRISED EVEN HIS
 OWN BACKERS. ELSEWHERE, THE GOVERNMENT COALITION CANDIDATES WERE
 STRONGER THAN DID THE BELAUNDE TICKET IN LAST JUNE'S MUNICIPAL
 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS. THIS SIGNIFICANT GOVERNMENT TRENDS IN A

STRONG ENDORSEMENT OF THE POLICIES OF THE BELAUNDE ADMINISTRATION
THE HEAVIEST DEFECTIONS AMONG THE OPPOSITION OCCURRED IN THE
STRONGHOLDS OF EX-GENERAL ODRIS'S UNO PARTY. THIS IS ATTRIBUTED TO
A LACK OF POLITICAL COHESION ON THE PARTY OF THE UNO, AS WELL AS
TO OPPOSITION AMONG THE PARTY'S MORE CONSERVATIVE ELEMENTS TO AN
ALIGNMENT WITH THE LEFTIST BUT ANTI-COMMUNIST AMERICAN POPULAR
