On the evening of 11 May, at 11:00 hours, Salvador ALLENDE GOSSENS, senator of the Partido Socialista and candidate of the Frente de Accion Popular in the 1958 presidential elections, accompanied by a Cuban army captain and four Cuban civilians, visited the headquarters of the Partido Comunista de Chile (PCCh) in Santiago.

Field Comment.

El Siglo, newspaper of the PCCh, on 11 May reported the return of ALLENDE from Buenos Aires, where he had attended the Medical Congress. Arriving with ALLENDE, according to the article, were the following Cuban medical doctors: Roberto GUERRA, president of the Sociedad de Angiologia de La Habana; Adolfo RODRIGUEZ de la Vega, captain, aide to the commandant, Ernesto (Ché) SUVARA; José Angel BUSTAMANTE, resident of the Executive de la Confederación Médica Panamericana; Rafael ACABO Fonseca, José LOPEZ Sanchez, José Miguel de SUVARA, Angela RUIZ Lopez, special representative of the 26th of July Movement. According to El Siglo, Dr. GUERRA was scheduled to be at the Hospital San Borja at 11:00 hours.
