SOURCE ⁰⁶ [redacted] (C) FROM SOVIET MINISTER AND RESIDENT DELEGATE IN GENEVA, NIKOLAI MOLYAKOV, A FORMER DEPARTMENT CHIEF IN THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

1. MINISTER MOLYAKOV TOLD A ⁰⁸ [redacted] DIPLOMAT DURING A CONVERSATION OF TWO HOURS THAT HE THOUGHT THE US ACTION WITH REGARD TO CUBA WAS "AN ELECTION AFFAIR". MOLYAKOV PROFESSED TO BELIEVE THAT PRESIDENT KENNEDY HAD DISCOVERED ON HIS ELECTION TOUR THAT HIS POPULARITY HAD DROPPED AND THAT HE HAD THEREUPON UNDERTAKEN THE CUBAN MEASURE TO "BECOME THE LEADER AGAIN" AND REGAIN MASS SUPPORT. IN MOLYAKOV'S OPINION THIS MEASURE HAS SUCCEEDED IN AGAIN MAKING PRESIDENT KENNEDY THE "MAN OF THE HOUR".
2. THE SOVIET DIPLOMAT COMMENTED THAT THE USSR WOULD NOT LET THE AMERICAN MOVE GO WITHOUT RETALIATION.
3. FIELD DISTRIBUTION: NCIB.
