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SUBJECT DEBRIEFING [redacted]

In August 60 Subject began working in resistance activities in the Propaganda Section of the MRR organization. In the Propaganda Section Subject worked for ^{ESTEBAN} Juan FALCON Zamar (ESTEBAN) and Jose Manuel ^{F. A. F. SANCHEZ ACOSTA} PERES (PEPE). Subject worked on week-ends only as she was a school teacher in Guanacay in Pinar del Rio. Her work was the distribution of anti-government literature, selling MRR bonds and recruiting people for type of work in the area of Guanacay.

In May 61 Subject left her job as school teacher and came to Havana to work full time for the MRR organization. Although Subject was still assigned to the Propaganda Section she worked for all sections of the MRR organization mainly as a courier.

On 26 July 61 Subject was involved in an action to kill Fidel Castro at the 26th of July ceremony at the Plaza Civic. The action was to kill Fidel Castro by firing a bazooka shell at the speaker's platform. This action failed because of a defective firing device in the bazooka. On returning to Subject's residence, a militiano halted the car in which Subject was a passenger, and demanded to search the car. As guns were concealed in the car, the militiano was shot and Subject was forced to change her place of residence.

During the period August 61-May 62 Subject travelled throughout Cuba with [redacted] ^{ESTEBAN ACOSTA} who at that time was the Civil Coordinator for the MRR, [redacted] ^{ALDO} National coordinator Workers Section, and [redacted] ^{ESTEBAN ACOSTA} who worked in the Action Section. Her function was to provide cover to the person she travelled with as the security forces would not normally check a man travelling with a woman. Subject remembered the following names of people that she contacted in her travels:

- a. [redacted] ^{ESTEBAN ACOSTA} who was the General Coordinator for the MRR in the Holguin area.
- b. [redacted] General Coordinator for Camaguey Province of the MRR.
- c. [redacted] ^{ESTEBAN ACOSTA} Military Coordinator for Oriente Province, and [redacted] who later came to Havana.

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d. [] named Johnny in Santiago de Cuba. Johnny owned a small lunch counter in that city and his place was a meeting place for MRR resistance organization in that city.

e. [] and [] in Santa Clara, Las Villas

On May 8, 62 Subject was to meet [] to finalize arrangements for selling a car. [] stated that if he did not show for the meeting scheduled at 1600 that [] would meet Subject. At 1600 Subject met [] who stated that [] could not make the meeting as he went to meet his wife. NOTE: LATER SUBJECT HEARD THAT [] WIFE MADE A CALL TO ONE OF THE MRR SAFEHOUSES AT 2300 AND INQUIRED ABOUT [] AS HE HAD NOT MET HER AS HAD BEEN ARRANGED. SUBJECT ALSO STATED THAT [] WIFE WAS A MILITIANO BUT STATED THAT THE REASON FOR HER BEING A MILITIANO WAS TO PROVIDE COVER FOR [] ACTIVITIES. WHEN I ASKED SUBJECT IF [] WIFE WAS A COMMUNIST SHE STATED NO.

On 9 May 62 Subject was contacted by [] who stated that her brother [] had been arrested, and that her brother had told her to alert others in the MRR organization. Subject tried to contact [] but a strange voice answered the telephone and started to ask question. Subject broke off the conversation. At 1400 Subject met with [] and [] and tried to warn other in the MRR organization by making telephone calls from the Libra Hote. MARR 5/11/62

On 12 May 62 Subject was contacted by [] last name possibly [] [] a muletto who worked with Arturo []. [] at that time headed the Action Section for coordinating guerrilla and resistance actions in the Provinces with the National Executive of the MRR. [] was very close to [] brought [] from HOLGUIN to work with him in Havana after [] was burned in Holguin. After the MRR roll up in May 62, [] was in contact with [] who in turn was in direct contact with []. During their conversation that day [] informed Subject of the arrest of MRR personnel, that he was in contact with [] and [] and asked Subject if she knew who had escaped the MRR roll up.

On 23 May 62 Subject was contacted by [] WHO INQUIRED MARR
who in the MRR organization was still free. Subject informed [] THAT

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the only persons still free were [redacted] and [redacted] *Roll up* *IN IS 3318-4* *ANFILLER FILE* *ROLL UP FILE*

[redacted] commented that it was a miracle that [redacted] had not been picked up as he was a loose talker and had poor personal security. Subject then arranged a meeting between [redacted] and [redacted] during the latter part of May 62. Since then she has not heard from [redacted] NOTE: WHEN AMHINT/27 WAS INFILTRATED INTO CUBA DURING THE LATTER PART OF MAY 62 HE CONTACTED [redacted]

During this period Subject heard that [redacted] had arranged a meeting with [redacted] and when he arrived at the meeting place he was arrested. [redacted] did not show for this meeting.

During the latter part of May [redacted] called Subject and stated that he had a meeting arranged with [redacted] but that [redacted] did not show for the meeting. A few days later SUBJECT heard that [redacted] had been arrested.

During the first days of June 62 [redacted] contacted Subject and informed her that [redacted] had informed on [redacted] At this time, [redacted] stated that an effort should be made to reorganize the MRR. Through [redacted] Subject had heard that [redacted] *Felician D. Cuba* a leader of the Workers Section of the MRR was trying to reorganize the MRR. *AFTER MAY 62 ROLL UP* Subject arranged a meeting between [redacted] and [redacted]

This meeting took place in a public park with SUBJECT, [redacted] and [redacted] of the Student Section present. NOTE: IN MARCH 63 SUBJECT WAS INFORMED BY [redacted] *Felician D. Cuba Sec F* SISTER OF [redacted] HE HAD BEEN SHOWN SURVEILLANCE PICTURES OF SUBJECT [redacted] AND OTHERS MEETING IN A PUBLIC PARK. To SUBJECT'S KNOWLEDGE THIS HAD BEEN THE ONLY TIME SHE HAD MET [redacted] AND IS POSITIVE THAT THE SURVEILLANCE PICTURE WAS TAKEN OF THE MEETING IN THE PUBLIC PARK IN MID JUNE 62. [redacted] WAS ARRESTED IN MAY 62 AND WAS IMPRISONED IN LA CABANA PRISON WHERE HE COULD RECEIVE VISITORS. At this meeting Subject stated that [redacted] was going to appear on television prior to [redacted] appearance on T.V. NOTE: ALTHOUGH [redacted] AND [redacted] WERE CLOSELY CONNECTED WITH THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE OF THE MRR NEITHER WERE ARRESTED IN THE MAY 62 ROLL UP.

Subject stated that during the MRR roll up she was never arrested or to her knowledge surveilled. Subject did not try to hide as she had no safehouse

or contacts to utilize. Subject is positive that the G-2 could have arrested her at any time if and when they decided it was necessary. Subject stated that the women arrested in the MRR roll up were all released. Subject believes that she was not arrested because of the Cuban government policy not to arrest and imprison women involved in the MRR resistance organization, and because she was only a courier in the organization.

Subject was informed in March 63 by [redacted] that her brother [redacted] had been shown numerous surveillance pictures of Subject and [redacted] by Cuban interrogators in La Cabana prison. The interrogators wanted [redacted] to identify the people in the photographs making contact with Subject and [redacted]. [redacted] stated that an interrogator named ~~SALGUEIRO~~ ^{SA-CUBA DC-64 INTERROG} had stated ^{SA-C} to [redacted] that the Cuban security forces knew everything that was going on in the resistance movement. They permitted these resistance organization to organize and exist until it was decided to roll up the group. SALGUEIRO cited as an example a small MRR group that had reorganized itself after June 62 under the leadership of [redacted] and [redacted]. In February 63, [redacted] was arrested. SALGUEIRO also stated that the brother of [redacted] was distributing MRR money to different people in Havana.

After AMBRONC ^{Executed} /5 was killed during the latter part of August 62, [redacted] was arrested by the G-2, kept in prison for a month and then released. Since then Subject has seen [redacted] in the streets of Havana but has not had contact with him since August 62.

From July 62 - until her exfiltration Subject has not participated in any clandestine work.
