SUBJECT: Administration Plan for ARAB Society
Activity - ARAB

I. OVERVIEW

1. KUBARK is supporting a revolutionary organization to further the aims of the United States in its efforts to combat Communism in PERU.

II. INSTRUMENTALITY

2. The Executive Committee of ARAB consists of high-ranking PERUVIAN elites, politicians and business leaders, all of whom are anti-Communists, and of whom are expected to hold positions in the new government when Communism is defeated in PERU. ARAB's support is in the form of stability for political and psychological action.

VII. BACKGROUND

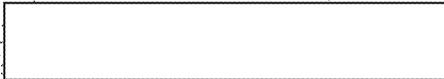
3. ARAB serves as a "front" for KUBARK supported political and psychological action, and as a rallying point for organized political elements in the country of elites. Funds introduced by KUBARK are for a two-fold purpose, i.e., (a) to support the efforts of ARAB and (b) to pay dependents of nonreturnees a monthly stipend. KUBARK is the largest contributor in support of this group.

IV. PARALLEL HISTORY

4. The present history of ARAB is approximately 1950-1951, 10 months which in due to coincide with the history of the ARAB. The ARAB received \$25,500.00 in 1951 for administrative support of the organization, and \$100,000.00 for nonreturnees dependents and apparatus operational expenses.

V. RECOMMENDATION

5. In order to authorize JMWK to make the above mentioned out-of-pocket payments, it is recommended that the attached Plan be approved. The Concurrence Sheet indicates that the Plan has been coordinated with interested Staffs and Divisions of KUBARK.
