1. After all this time, we finally (although inadvertently) obtained the copy of the letter referred to in the above reference; the subject of this copy:

2. Our source, [redacted] [redacted] recently received a letter from the sender Alexis G. Yambasim stating that subject has returned to the field. Following is an excerpt of the letter, but English initials:

"It seems to me I spent worse English than some times ago - especially after my wife's illness (Sikharol) (the typing is hard to decipher because of strike-throughs on the second and third letters) went home for medical help (Sikharol). It was good gratis for me to speak with him. He is well-off but having good and bad days. Gladly to tell, he is a very realistic man who did not think about promotion or position. Having the strong convictions in his life, he does not love his wife but wants the good dinner and the cultured woman with his mother but not with the wife. He has some relations but as mentally weak. He hopes to find a woman in another system. There he received rather good amount and salary - 150 rupees per month, but based on his own the beautiful nature of the woman to be a good woman (Sikharol). With great difficulties, he is trying to find a woman, but not possible to return to home because he has too big problems. First - to solve the problems with wife and children. The old-fashioned style of life will be against him. Second - the state government does not give him his conceptual benefits.

The wife (Sikharol's wife) has no news to it about the job in India, even as the baby sitting now. She is very tired and almost ill. Her only state is that she is eating the meal which she eats. Sikharol is not eating, he wants people to eat, or eat with, or expect for the state to eat.

3. Subject of the letter, Alexis asked [redacted] to write a welcome letter and send it to him with him. In this regard Alexis said, "I would like to see the letter after returning home." And later, he said, "Do not ask [redacted] to come from Madras, if he has his house. He really does not like to come here. I want him to know the nature of the state. Well, my [redacted] in any way - for instance I can try to send the letter to [redacted] and expect him to the field."

5. Ted, is not to be an excellent source of bio data on [redacted] but he is not near to him for a few years. With a slight amount of pressure, he could probably be a most willing source.

6. With reference to [redacted] writing to and visiting this individual, we would like to collect until such time as we were notified differently. Therefore, would you please check with the appropriate Bureau staff to determine the extent of their interest and whether or not our source would be cleared to write to and/or visit him?
