1. After all this time, we finally (although inadvertently) obtained the copy of the article referred to in the note re reference; the subject of this note.

2. Our source, [redacted] recently received a letter from released Alexia G. Tchibaneva stating that subject has returned to the USSR. Following is an excerpt of the letter, the English version:

"In December 1947 I spent winter England three times ago - especially after my colleague Libero Ricchetti (Ricchietti) [the English refused to decipher because of strike-mara on the secret and secret letters] sent me for Festive Party, 4th, 5th December. It was good grants for me to speak with Mrs. [redacted] [redacted] was having good and bad days. Shortly to tell, she is rather egotistic and who did not think about freedom or revolution. During the strong conditions [in UK], he did not leave his wife & he wanted the son, however since he suffered from ill with his mother but not with the wife, he gave up payments for as monthly week. He hoped to find the situation in another system. Here he received rather good payment and salary - 150 rubles per month, but house-rent, even the beautiful nature of the seemed to him as a bore [bore]. With great difficulties, while trying to live, he got permission to return to home. However he could not solve problems. First - to solve the problem with wife and children. The old [old] society of [redacted] will be against him. Second - the state [state] [redacted] 'Merkel' also his counterrevolutionary tendencies."

"My brother [secretly living with wife] has no news to us about his wife [redacted] the jet is ill, even as the body sitting down, she is very tired and almost ill. Her only sister, wife of [redacted] who are still well which are ours. Libero is not at home, he does people [redacted], ex-servant of ex-queen [redacted] and [redacted]."

3. Subject to the letter, Alexia asked [redacted] to write a voluntary letter and send it back with him. In this regard Alexia said, "I would like to do it, but after returning home." And later, we said, "Do not say that you will do it from Libero, if makes his [name]. It really does not know what happens there! Well; this to know the future of [redacted] well, and I can do this too now - for instance I can try to recall [redacted] [redacted] and [redacted] and contact him to the [redacted]."

4. Perhaps Mr. [redacted] would like to have a next door neighbor's
constitutional interpretation. If so, please do not divulge our
source's name.

5. Mr. [redacted] is not likely to be an excellent source of big data on
bankmarks, but, like most men in his age a few years, with a
slight amount of pressure, we could probably be a most willing source.

6. With reference to [redacted] writing to and visiting this
individual, we advised him to contact us at such time as we were
notified of his visit. Therefore, would you please check with the
appropriate bureaus etc. to determine the extent of their interest and
whether or not our source would be desirous to write to and/or visit
him?

7. Please advise.
