SWISS FEDERAL POLICE ADVISED UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL IN CONVERSATION WITH RICHARD THOMAS GIBSON, MENTIONED IN RECAB, IS FREDY GILBERT NILS ANDERSSON, WHOSE BACKGROUND APPEARS IN CIA MEMO DATED SEPTEMBER 10 LAST ENTITLED RICHARD THOMAS GIBSON. SFP ALSO ADVISED INDICATIONS GIBSON WILL GO TO PARIS FROM LAUSANNE SOME TIME BEFORE DECEMBER 15 NEXT.

[] CHIEF OF CIA, [] STATES HE RECEIVED CABLE FROM [] HEADQUARTERS INQUIRING ABOUT FEASIBILITY OF INTERVIEW OF GIBSON CONCERNING WHETHER HE CAN THROW ANY LIGHT ON OSWALD'S ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT. [] WISHES TO COORDINATE WITH LEGAT BERN. I CONSIDER SUCH INTERVIEW LOGICAL AND DESIRABLE. INTERVIEW CAN BE CONDUCTED BY ROBERT C. ODE, EXPERIENCED AND RELIABLE EMBASSY CONSULAR OFFICER, AFTER CLEARING WITH AMBASSADOR. GIBSON CAN BE REQUESTED TO COME TO EMBASSY FOR INTERVIEW OR ODE WILL GO TO LAUSANNE IF NECESSARY.
