Vicente Eladio Valdez Valladares, domiciled at No. 4 calle Ballesta, piso 2, Madrid, and Hector Alfonso y Ruiz, domiciled at No. 4 calle Campomanes, piso 4, Madrid, are special delegates of the group in Spain.
