The title of this case has been marked "changed" to reflect the addition of the maternal surname of the subject as reflected in the files of the CIA station in

The CIA station advises that the subject is undoubtedly identical with the RICARDO LORIE mentioned on Page 24 of the report of SA ROBERT JAMES DWYER dated 8/5/58 at Miami concerning the July 26 Revolutionary Movement in Miami. The CIA station has advised that exptioned subject was one of the principal leaders of the July 26 action group and occupied a position described as "Chief of the War Department" for the rebels. The CIA station further advised that the subject has returned to Cuba.

Relet of 12/5/58 requested details concerning the arrests of Cuban rebels described in the CIA report dated 11/25/58, captioned "Information on Cuban Rebel Aircraft Headed for Venezuela." Available details concerning these arrests were set forth in my letter of 1/26/59 in the STURGIS case. This information is as follows:

"A news clipping from the Mexico City daily newspaper, "Excelsior," of November 25, 1958, entitled "Action Against Cuban Rebels at Apatzingan - Judicial Action at Morelia Against the Eleven Smugglers," reported that eleven persons had been arrested at Uruapan at dawn on 11/20/58, when they were discovered endeavoring to send arms to the rebels of FIDEL CASTRO RUZ in Cuba. The article listed the following as having been arrested:

"Meanwhile, on 11/4/58, FIORINI departed from Mexico City in the automobile and is reported to have met DIAZ LANZ and DE LA LORIE at Yuma, Arizona. (X) (U)

"On 11/8/58, they are reported to have been at the Highway House Motel at Phoenix, Arizona. believed that from Phoenix they proceeded to Kingman, Arizona, where they made the purchase of a C-46 airplane which had been U.S. Government surplus and which was purchased and registered in FIORINI's name, even though it is presumed that the funds were provided by the two Cubans.

*From Phoenix, Arizona, the group flew the airplane to Veracruz and Acapulco, Mexico, before proceeding to Apatzingan.
