Reports contained in those of a controlled American source and of the Legal Attache, identify the subject as a former member of the Communist Party. He is said to have been dismissed from the Party on August 27, 1945, following publication in his own newspaper, "TTEMPO EN CUBA", of an article critical of the editor of the Communist newspaper "HOY" as a "...collaborator with the enemies of the people, with North American monopolistic ... no imperialist capital..." A CAS report of November 4, 1947, describes Sr. Masferrer as pro-Russian, pro-Bolshevik and an advocate of the Marxist Revolution. He was, in the same report, further reported to have stated, as late as
