1. This Agency is in receipt of information dated 23 March 1961 to the effect that the three individuals listed above, all reportedly in television work and all Venezuelans, have recently arrived in Spain.

Luis Gerarde TOVAR Carrillo, born in Caracas, Venezuela, on 3 October 1932, traveling on Venezuelan Jum passport number 112100 issued in Caracas on 26 November 1956, arrived in Madrid from New York City on 6 March 1961. He has recently been in the USSR and is a member of the Venezuelan Communist Party.

Angel Leopoldo RODRIGUEZ Ochoa, a Venezuelan, arrived in Spain with TOVAR. This Agency has no further information on this individual.

Manuel TRUJILLO Gonzalez, born 28 March 1925 at Puerto Cabello, Venezuela, traveling on Venezuelan passport number 197272 issued in Caracas, entered Spain. from France on 8 December 1960. TRUJILLO is reported to be a newspaperman who as of 1954 was a (pro-Communist) columnist for <u>Ultimas Noticas</u>, a Venezuelan publication.
