It is known that the Mexican Foreign Minister was obviously disturbed by the knowledge of the note sent by the Cuban Government to the Mexican Government attributing to it participation in a plot aimed at involving the CASTRO Government in the plan for the attack on KENNEDY. Because of this, it is felt that there may be a change in the well-known Mexican position toward the Cuban problem.
