	The conference on foreign affairs and peace organized by the "Committee of Indian Parliamentarians for Peace" (my  (A)) was opened on Saturday by the Prime Minister, who dwelt on the beneficent effects of the lessening of tension between East and West and on the necessity that the efforts in this direction should not be interrupted as a consequence of President KENNEDY's assassination. He repeated the Indian Government's attachment to the policy of nonalignment despite Chinese aggression, which it had been obliged to stop by force, and pointed out that it is not enough to denounce war, but that it is advisable to find means to prevent it.  The only foreign representatives despite the efforts of DIWAN CHAMAN LALL, who incidentally had asked me to obtain messages from

in the seminar as a private individual.

As for the Indians, the (B val leading voices) are on the whole either crypto-communist or left-wing members of Parliament. We might name Mrs. ARUNA ASAF ALI among the former and Mr. MALAVIYA, Former Minister of Fuel, and (B val Mr. KRISHNA MENON) among the latter. The last-named, in his speech, made a point of stating that in spite of the provocations of China and Pakistan, India was maintaining her peaceful policy. He observed that there can be disarmament or peace only to the extent that there is a rapprochement between the USSR and the United States: "The more these two powers work together, the better it will be for the world."
