WARREN COMMISSION FINDINGS SUMMARIZED

As announced at the beginning of this week, the report of the commission headed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, which investigated the assassination of President KENNEDY, was handed to President JOHNSON yesterday. The report is very lengthy, but is to be printed for wide distribution, according to the desire of President JOHNSON that there be no doubts in regard to the circumstances and motivation of that crime.

Sunday afternoon, the day after tomorrow, the report will be made public, which will make possible its transcription in the morning press on Monday.

The ceremony of handing the report to President JOHNSON was attended by all members of the commission appointed by him, which became known as the WARREN Commission and which was made up of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, Senator RICHARD RUSSELL and JOHN SHERMAN COOPER, Congressman HALE BOGGS and GERALD FORD and our Mr. JOHN J. MCCLOY and Mr. ALLEN DULLES.

It appears that the conclusion of the WARREN Commission is that LEE OSWALD was the sole author of the crime and that his motive was strictly personal. In regard to the assassination of OSWALD, the Commission appears to have accepted the thesis that JACK RUBY also acted on strictly personal motivation both evidently having suffered from mental unbalance or instability.
