## UNITED STATES REPORTED WILLING TO FORGET CAMBODIAN INCIDENT

3 Jan 64 1838

I was received this morning, Friday 3 January at 1100 hours by [ ] Foreign Minister [ ]. He told me that America is ready to forget entirely the incident with Cambodia since Cambodia has already denied having manifested any rejoicing over the death of [President] KENNEDY. President [ ] had an interview yesterday with Mr. [ ] and American Ambassador STEVENSON. The [ ] Government thinks that Cambodia and America will be willing to forget any past incident and so will accept the formula of a joint statement.

President [ ] and Mr. [ ] wish sincerely to receive a trusted representative of His Royal Highness in an interview in [ ]. But if, on the contrary, His Royal Highness wishes for President [ ] to send a [ ] representative to Phnom Penh, the President will conform with the desire of His Royal Highness. Meanwhile, the [ ] Foreign Minister is ordering Ambassador [ ] to return from [ ]. Unfortunately [ ] son just died in an accident in [ ].
