A A fellow named [redacted]

Q And Mr. Fitzgerald?

A Yes, and I really can't recall some of the other people. We were -- [redacted] at that time, in Paris, [redacted] and we felt that it was probably bugged, so all conversations took place -- we walked around the garden and tyat type of thing, and, you know, I was walking with somebody, somebody was in front of me, and you just overhear conversations.

Q This was in Paris?

Q Was it your understanding that the Agency had received instructions with respect to this activity from another component of the Government?
