sources like publications (many from places friendly to Cuba)  
had select few who when freedom flights began  
would interview some people coming out - would  
single people out on basis of biographical forms.  
Interrog for CI leads - turned over to Cuban  
squad of Miami FBI.  
Will be phased out in June.

Was under a commercial cover - called AMOTS.  
in 1963 (begin) - Ted Shesley (now chief EA)  
began when he was COJ  
was full time  
eyes & ears into Cuban community  
can't recall much about what they did

[ written history of AMOTS - by how  
started what they did - Cuban was  
titular head - ]  
also had cover offices in  
the Bldg.

much they did was w/ the  
knowledge of CIA

Ran radio station directed to Cuba - located on  
Swamp Island

after defected Castro's sister - CIA set her up -  
gave her lump sum each month to pay for  
expenses - taped radio broadcasts & bought  
time from stations in W. I. thru

CIA just term'd her - she became uncontrolled

other portions of AMOT

some skilled people - set up intercept operation  
Outpost of domestic NSA couldn't follow  
24 hrs a day - 40 people - got complete coverage  
of the island - reg + maritime nets, boarder  
defenses + internal military nets -

No domestic intercepts - directed entirely at Cuban  
comm - run by CIA + w/ CIA funds but WSA  
did the targeting - gave the frequencies they  
wanted targeted -

Agents were full time employees + CIA cover officers there  
at all times + before an action, an act cover officer supposed  
to approve -

picketers in NY + Miami

no record of checks w/ cover officer before done

Tommy Spangola was cover officer

[ ] Station still targeting against Cuban comm  
had to report anything suspicious of militant activities,  
Alfa 66, or anything of fer intel value.

Some of the comm had become US-  
citizens by then -

All Cuban ops now moved back to beagle + 127  
now does only cover ops -
