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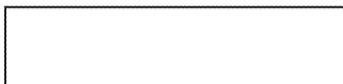

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


1) 2/6/62 Memo in lieu of Witness Report indicates that  departed NDS for a field assignment on 7/31/62.
