name to which unid'd call
intended to refer may have been
Manuel Garcia Gonzales.

Press reported that Garrison
alleges that Garcia was one of
JFK's assassins. However, another
report from FBI N.O. 6/April 67
quote Dean Adams Andrew
as saying that Garcia doesn't
exist & that Andrew identified the
name. CIA has no other record
of Garcia.

Elena Garro, the complainant is subject
of 201-800405. She is described as
erratic & illogical. "It is evident
from her allegation (10 Dec 68) that
she had access to public source
info. which helped shape her
thinking. I have checked the
WC Master Index, the Oswald
file (both negative) and discussed
this matter w/ Charles Bonds
of the Mexican Desk. On the
basis of what I have read about
Elena Garro, and my knowledge
of the Oswald case, I would give
no credence to the info."

Giron's activities are believed have
little bearing on the invest.
