TRANSLATION of the postscript written by [REDACTED]

Dear Brother-heart !

As you have not let us hear anything from you, we are trying once again. If this (letter) does not get a reply I will leave you in peace. [REDACTED] says that we live our lives here and Moma should live her life. I hope you will not be angry with [REDACTED] because he had written this letter. We know that it is not your fault. [REDACTED] said that I should ask you if you are coming for Christmas. We do hope so. This week we move into new accommodation, 2 rooms and a kitchen. So we have bought new curtains, a large dining-room table, 4 chairs and a gas-cooker. You see, we are getting forward. We also have a budgerigar. He is called [REDACTED]. Today he gave [REDACTED] a kiss. You should have seen it. And in the morning, if I do not get up at once, he makes a noise until I do get up and talk to him.
