Source, Span seaman fell in love with Soviet girl, Atery/Etery GRUSDEVA who in summer 1958 serving as host-ess Interklub Leningrad. Source visited Leningrad Oct 1958 again and this time Atery took him on two occasions to apt of a girl friend, Svetlana LARIONOVAYA (sic). Svetlana lived with parents Naberezhnaya Robesp'era, 32, kv 24. Svetlana showed source photo of a German boyfriend. Source thinks Svetlana spoke some German and a few words of French.
